Innovative Schedule

To aid our students in making a smooth transition from high school to college, Ladywood has incorporated alternative block scheduling. Students select 7 or 8 classes per semester, resulting in students having 3 or 4 classes daily, each lasting 80 minutes.

Graduation from Ladywood requires successful completion of at least 26.00 credits, which must include:

- 4.0 credits Theology
- 4.0 credits English
- 4.0 credits Mathematics
- 3.0 credits Social Science (Economics, American History and Government)
- 3.0 credits Science
- 1.0 credit Health/Physical Education
- 1.0 credit Fine Arts (Music/Art/Drama)
- 1.0 credit Computer Technology
- 5.0 additional credits
- 2.0 credits Foreign Language required - Elementary or High School
