The combined score of the two highest scoring students from each school becomes the team score and counts 40% in the state finals.

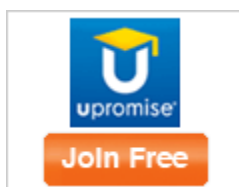
